## **What is an X-ray?**

X-rays are a form of electromagnetic radiation just like visible light.

## **What does an X-ray show?**

X-rays are used for many purposes, including determining if a bone is broken, seeing whether an internal organ is infected, and looking for cancer. The X-ray will show your doctor a two-dimensional picture of your body and is a good screening tool to evaluate for causes of many common disorders.

## **How is an X-ray performed?**

The X-rays are produced by an electrical machine. The patient stands between the machine and a special screen used for obtaining the image. The patient is asked to keep as still as possible for the few seconds it takes for each image to be obtained.
